37.95.121(6)

(6) Any outdoor play area must be maintained free from hazards such as wells, machinery and animal waste. If any part of the play area is adjacent to a busy roadway, drainage or irrigation ditch, stream, large holes, or other hazardous areas, the play area must be enclosed with a fence in good repair that is at least 4 feet high without any holes or spaces greater than 4 inches in diameter or natural barriers to restrict children from these areas.

The intent of this rule was not met:

Based on observation, CCL found that the outdoor area was not free from hazards. The cord for the sprinkler system was running across the entrance to the play area creating a tripping hazard.

This plan of correction was accepted on May 1, 2017.
