License</li> <li>37.95.623(1)(a-d)</li> <li>(1) The child to staff ratio for day care center is: <ul> <li>(a) 4:1 for children zero months through 23 months;</li> <li>(b) 8:1 for children two years through three years;</li> <li>(c) 10:1 for children four years through five years; and</li> <li>(d) 14:1 for six years and over</li> </ul> </li> <li>The intent of this rule was not met:</li> <li>Based on observation and interview, CCL found that ratio requirements were not met for a period of approximately 10-15 minutes. There were 14 children ages 2 and up in care with 1 caregiver and 5 children under age 2 in care with 1 other caregiver. To meet ratio requirements, 2 caregivers were needed for each age group. The director stated that one caregiver had an emergency errand and would be right back and the other caregiver was on the way. Within about 10-15 minutes after CCL's arrival, both additional caregivers had arrived.</li> </ul>
