As discussed during the inspection, the basinet that is used for napping a 6 month old is not approved for napping any child as it has a slight incline. Please use it for infants when they are awake only. Also, as of February 2018 all infants under the age of one year cannot have a blanket during sleep times. Flapless sleep sacks that do not restrict the infant's arms are acceptable. Lastly, please secure the outside fence in the southwest corner to building better to eliminate the space between the two.

Before a regular registration can be approved all staff must be on the practitioner registry. Additionally, staff that did not take the Health and Safety Overview in 2016 must take the orientation trainings.
