A copy of the report shall be provided to the parents of the children involved, and a copy retained on file at the day care facility. The intent of this rule was not met: Based on interview, CCL found that provider did not submit a report to the department within 24 hours to inform of the following information: a child in care was perceived to have an medical issue which resulted in the child requiring ambulance transport and physician treatment.

Νο	 33. First Aid Requirements 37.95.183(1) (1) Each provider shall adopt and follow written policies for first aid consistent with recommendations from the American Red Cross. These policies must include but are not limited to: (a) procedures for handling medical emergencies, including calling the Emergency Montana Poison Control Center at 1 (800) 222-1222 when a child is suspected of having ingested any poisonous or toxic substance; and (b) directions for calling parents or someone else designated as responsible for the child when a child is sick or injured. The intent of this rule was not met: Based on interview, CCL found that 6 of 6 caregivers interviewed stated they did not know the standard procedure they were expected to take when handling a medical emergency. 6 of the 6 caregivers interviewed stated they did not sign an acknowledgement indicating that they understood the providers written policies, to include the facilities standard first aid procedures.
